


MOODLE IS UPGRADING

This guide introduces some of the key changes

Collapse the Left Hand Navigation



The new left hand navigation bar on the left of your Moodle page can now be collapsed using the 'Collapse All' button at the top of the menu.

Return to where you were

When you go to a sub-page and hit the back button on your browser, Moodle now remembers where you were and takes you back to that spot on the page.

Labels have titles and appear on the menu

Labels now have the option of adding titles and will appear on the new left hand navigation menu.


Clearer Topics
