- Funding for individual researchers
- Competitive salary up to €87,500 per annum (dependent on experience)
- Simple to run no timesheets, flat rate funding
- Dedicated support from application to award via RGS and professional grant-writer
- No restrictions on nationality
- Open to researchers from ANY subject area

4 Steps to a Marie Curie Fellowship

- 1. Check your eligibility
- Identify a host institution and co-researcher/supervisor there with a research project in mind
- 3. Get in touch with Nottingham to receive advice and support with your application (contact details below).
- 4. Submit your proposal.
