**Re: 2014 Taiwan Fellowship**

I am pleased to inform you that 2014 Taiwan Fellowship, sponsored by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of China (Taiwan), will accept the applications from 1<sup>st</sup> May to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2014. It is to encourage experts and scholars worldwide to conduct the research in Taiwan's universities, colleges or research institutes between 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2015 and 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2015.

The duration of a fellowship is from three months to one year up to his/her research proposal in Taiwan. The field of study should be stipulated in the social sciences and humanities with a topic related to Taiwan, cross-strait relations, mainland China, the Asia Pacific and Sinology.

The scholars/researchers will be requested to obtain a "Letter of Consent for Research" from Taiwan's universities, colleges or research institutes once they are selected as the candidates for the fellowship. The list of candidates will be released around September to October 2014. A fellowship recipient will be entitled to a monthly stipend of NTD 50,000 or NTD 60,000 (about RM 5,000 or RM 6,000) and a NTD35,000 (about RM3,500) subsidy for a direct round-trip economy-class air ticket between his/her country of residence and Taiwan.

The applicants are requested to apply on Taiwan Fellowship website (<http://taiwanfellowship.ncl.edu.tw>) and send their application forms with related documents (personal CV, research proposal, and two reference letters) to my Office by post for preliminary evaluation after the completion of online registration.
