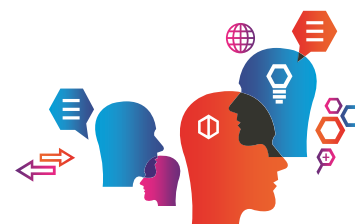

Purpose of the Committees:
