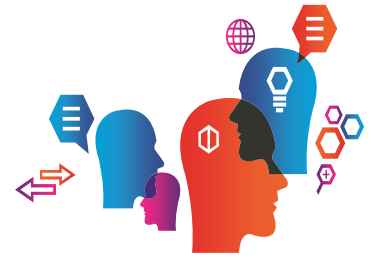

Purpose of the Committees:

The EUMCCI Committees are platforms for EUMCCI members of specific sectors. The Committees meet regularly to discuss issues affecting their particular industries, to hold seminars with guest speakers from the government, academia and business and to lobby with the government. At the moment, EUMCCI has 13 Committees.
