Purpose of the Committees:

At the moment, EUMCCI has 13 Committees.

Committee primary objectives:

- A platform for European oil and gas SMEs and Malaysian SMEs to network and to discuss common industry issues
- To establish close institutional and B2B relationships, especially with the Malaysian Oil & Gas Services Council (MOGSC)
- To find synergies with key stakeholders such as PEMANDU, Malaysian Gas Association (MGA), and Malaysia Petroleum Resources Corporation (MPRC)

Focus areas:

- Examine opportunities in the oil and gas industry between EU and Malaysia, e.g. technical know-how and expertise sharing between EU and Malaysia
- Policy and regulations

Programme for 2015:

- Quarterly general meetings
- Site visits and institutional visits to Petronas, e.g. to the Refinery and Petrochemical Integrated Development (RAPID) project, and also to other large Malaysian companies
- Organise trade missions, look for partners in Europe and participate in Trade Fairs and Congresses
